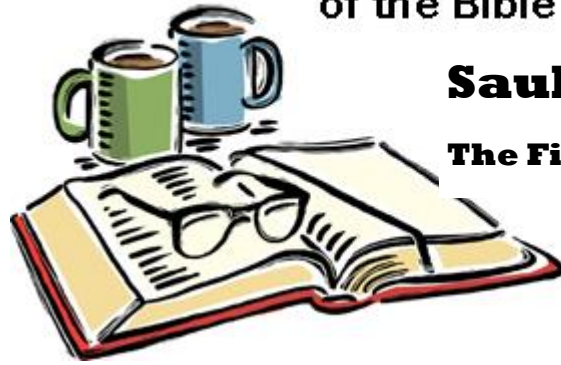




## Great Men of the Bible
